Your patient has requested a referral for a specialist orthopaedic opinion.

I would be happy to oblige, but in keeping with usual medical practice, I have asked that a formal referral is made from a medical professional such as their family doctor, another medical specialist, a physiotherapist or osteopath.

The referral should include:

- The reason for referral
- The relevant history of their concern
- Any investigations undertaken
- Any treatment provided to date
- Date of injury and ACC number (if the concern is accident-related)
